The PATRIOT FLAG



Raising the Flag: (6 people min)

Weather permitted – If it will rain, a static display can be used such as a high school gym

- Park the Ladder Truck with the nose into the wind (Two ladder trucks can be used)
- Prepare the ladder by extending it out and lowering the bed about 8 feet off the ground
- One fire fighter in the ladder to prepares the rope around the rail carabiner attached
- Un-tuck the blue edge and unfurl the flag to the point where the spine is accessible
- One fire fighter hand the spine of the flag – hook to the fire fighter in the ladder bed and attaches the spine ends loops to the rope – carabiner
- Raise the ladder slowly with personnel on the ground suspending the flag

Lowering the Flag: (12 people min)

- Lower the ladder to point where at least 3 – 4 personnel can secure the flag
- Walk the flag out with additional personnel on the sides of the flag
- Disconnect the carabiners from the flag while suspending it
- Fold the flag length wise to about 5 feet in width
- Fold the flag in triangles

There are only a few requirements pertaining to the flag raising - flying:

- That the flag is raised for a time period that will effect an impact.
- The Pledge of Allegiance is recited. Boy or Girl Scouts or high school representative an official can lead the pledge
- The two Flags: Flag of Honor and Flag of Heroes are displayed. Halyard and hardware supplied.
- The log book is signed by official city members
- The flag is re-folded with respect and honor (minimum 12 tall people needed)
- It is placed back in the box with all of the halyards and equipment
- The shipping new destination label (provided) is applied to the box and delivered to FedEx
- A Resolution and or Proclamation from the City and or State is welcomed (sample provided)

Additional options such as color guards – honor guards and ceremonies are at the host cities discretion. Red Skeltons Pledge of Allegiance can be read. The Flag of Honor and Flag of Heroes can be purchased using the attached order form. The funds generated from the sales will support the 10 year Anniversary Display in NYC, Washington DC and Shanksville PA. via the NYC 9/11 Memorial Field / WORLD MEMORIAL. After the yearlong tour, we will drive the flag across the country beginning August 22 2011 flying the flag along the way. The flag will then be flown in NYC, Washington DC and Shanksville PA on 09/11/11 for the Ten Year Anniversary.
